

Cut out tag, fold on the dotted line and tape together ends. Attach to your gift of an amaryllis.



Move flowers.

Once flowers start to open, indirect light is best.

Snip off flowers as they fade. Cut the stems about an inch from the base after all flowers have bloomed. Strappy leaves prow as the flowering period ends.

Wait patiently. Most amaryllis will bloom four to six weeks after planting.

Keep the pot warm. Amaryllis are touchy about cool breezes. Put the pot in a draft-free spot.

Place the pot in a sunny spot. Water sparingly until a flower spike appears. Soil should be moist but never soggy.

 $m Water \ well.$ Allow water to drain through the pot and make sure the water stays below the top of the bulb.
